### Welcome NRMGC Tournament Players:

We're delighted to have you participating in the 38th Annual National Retired Military Golf Classic (NRMGC). We want you and your family to have a wonderful week of golf and comradeship. The dedicated sponsors and courses that you see along the borders of this letter are the key players who make this tournament the biggest and the best retired military golf tournament in the world, and we ask that you thank them whenever you have an opportunity.

Since the entire hole-in-one pot was won last year, we will start a new hole-in-one pot for the hole-in-one competition again this year by taking a portion of each player's entry. Any player(s) with a hole-in-one this year will receive a share of the pot; i.e. if there is one hole-in-one, that player gets the entire pot, two holes-in-one, the two players split the pot, etc. If there are no holes-in-one this year, the pot will carry over until next year and be added to the pot created next year, thereby creating a larger pot. When there is a hole-in-one winner(s), the winner(s) will be paid in cash at the end of the tournament.

### DAILY DRAWINGS

Drawings for \$50 gift certificates are held the first three days of the tournament. The winners' sheets of those drawings will also be posted the following morning at all of the courses. Be sure to check the list of winners each day.

### GOLF COURSES

Founders Group International is providing six excellent venues for our use during the tournament. **ALL MEN'S TEE TIMES WILL BE SHOTGUN STARTS AT 8:00AM.** Men will play four of the six courses according to their schedules, which will be posted at Myrtle Beach National on registration day. The ladies will play Burning Ridge on Wednesday (2 Jun), Myrtlewood Pine Hills on Thursday (3 Jun) and the West Course at Myrtle Beach National on Friday (4 Jun). **ALL LADIES' STARTING TIMES WILL BE A SHOTGUN START AT 8:30 AM.**

*Men age 70-79 on the first day of tournament competition will play from the forward "senior" tees. Men and women age 80 and above on the first day of tournament competition will play from the "super senior" tees.*

Teams with the lowest score on each course each day will win a prize. The announcements and award of winning teams will be conducted the following morning prior to the next round at the next course in the rotation.

**Tips for the bag handlers ARE NOT included in the entry fee. Please remember them as you would at your own course.**

### SOCIAL EVENTS

Due to COVID 19 concerns and restrictions, we will not have an Ice Breaker for this event.

Women - Ladies' awards will be presented on Friday, 4 June, at the Myrtle Beach National Golf Club. Putting contest will begin at approximately 2:00 PM. Tournament award presentation will begin at approximately 3:00 PM; prizes will be awarded for the top five (5) places.

Men - Men's awards will be presented on Saturday, 5 June, at the Myrtle Beach National Golf Club. Putting contest will begin at approximately 2:00 PM. Tournament award presentation will begin at approximately 3:00 PM. Men please note that prizes for the first nine places will be awarded at the ceremony on Saturday AND MUST BE CLAIMED AT THAT TIME—THOSE PRIZES WILL NOT BE MAILED. Prizes for places 10 - 19 are PGA Tour Superstore gift cards and will be emailed to the winners. The email gift cards may be used at the stores in Myrtle Beach and elsewhere as well as by telephone or online. They do not expire and may also be redeemed when you return next year. As always, our goal is to provide you the most enjoyable golf experience possible.
